People with gifts of all kinds are attracted to CES and give generously of their time, money and spirit because they see clearly the impact of CES service to those living in poverty in the Phillips neighborhood.

STRATEGY 3 – Leveraging Partnerships for Effectiveness

The condition that will exist if we are successful:

Lives are transformed because we chart a path and guide those in need to and through a mosaic of resources working in concert to relieve their poverty and hopelessness.
